Reunion Schedule

- 10am Cooks set up.
- 10am-1050am Check-in and unloading.
- 11am Dropoff area closed; area is now pedestrian traffic only.
- 11am Class set up in designated area.
- 12pm 6pm Reunion activates start.
- 6pm End of Reunion activity.
- 6pm 7pm Cleanup
- 7pm Leaving the property.

Check-in

- All participating classes check-in at the Executive Board tent before unloading. You will be directed to your designated area. Class will be in graduation order starting with the most senior class of 1972 and ending with the class of 1992.
- Classes that are cooking onsite please let the committee know. Cooks will check in at the Alumni Executive tent and you will then be directed to your cooking area.

Unloading/Cooks

- Each Class is allowed 2 vehicles at a time in their designated area for unloading. Please limit your loading time to 10 minutes, do not leave your vehicle running. Violators are subject to vehicles being removed.
- Cooks are to unload grills or park grills in the designated area. Vehicles must be disconnected from grill trailers and parked in the parking lot.
- No grilling/frying is allowed in the parking lot, on the sidewalk, or concrete, or the grass.
 Grilling/frying is only allowed in the designated cooking area.

Parking

Parking is available to all on the property also in the surrounding neighborhood, please
respect homeowners posted parking signs & do NOT block anyone's driveway. Illegal parking
may subject your vehicle to towing at the owner's experience.
